There will be a number of road closures involving the surrounding area of each start and finish location. These closures will be finalised well in advance of the race taking place and will be published on the web site In between each start and finish there will be a 'rolling road closure' system. This is where the race route and junctions with access roads onto the route are closed while the race passes through. The length of closure of the rolling road block depends upon how dispersed the riders are. Typically, the 4 lead motorcycle instigating the closure is 15 minutes ahead of the lead rider. The closure then remains in place until all riders and race cars have passed through.
