

TOUR OF BRITAIN: NOTTINGHAMSHIRE ROUTE

Rolling road closures of the race route – including any side roads – will start 15-20 minutes ahead of the lead rider and remain in place until all riders and race cars have passed through. This will be managed by police escort vehicles.

The exact length of these rolling road closures depend upon how dispersed the riders are.

In order to create the required width for the race, no waiting restrictions will be in operation from 8am – 4pm throughout the race route. This restriction will be lifted as soon as possible after all the riders have passed through and all operational activities have been completed.

There will also be specific race day closures at the start and finish venues as follows:-

RACE Start : West Bridgford

All of Central Avenue will be closed from 4am to 3pm

Bridgford Road (between Stratford Road to Rectory Road) will be closed from 4am to 3pm

NO WAITING restrictions for the whole length of Rectory Road from 4am to 3pm

RACE Finish: Mansfield

A6191 Chesterfield Road South (from Abbott Road to Rosemary Street) road closed from 5am to 5pm

A6191 Chesterfield Road South from Rosemary Street to Crow Hill Drive road closed from 2pm to 5pm

A6009 Rosemary Street (Chesterfield Road South to Civic Centre Access Road) road closed from 2pm to 5pm

To avoid these rolling closures, the advice is to look at the route of the race and avoid that road for about one hour either side of the predicted time of the race passing through.
